The level of Disclosure is based on the degree of contact with children generally applicable to these positions, in accordance with the CRB's category coding system. PCCs will need to assess whether a Disclosure is required, and at what level, in respect of other positions – such as sacristans, vergers, sidepersons, church/church hall cleaners and kitchen staff. The decision will depend on circumstances and supervisory arrangements.
