The aim during Fairtrade Fortnight 2010 which runs from 22nd February until 7th March is to achieve one million and one swaps. When you would normally buy non-fairtrade items you are encouraged to swap and buy fairtrade. Perhaps this is the moment to change to using Poterion Fairtrade Communion Wine from your usual communion wine. You can register your swap at thebigswap.org.uk and also see how many other swaps have been made. The wine is produced at Stellar Organic Winery in South Africa. Stellar is a leading Fairtrade winery with many ongoing projects aimed at improving the lives and community facilities of its workers. On the wish list for the future are the following:

- The purchase of a bus for transporting seasonal workers to and from the farms and cellar and for use on social occasions
- The building of a new community centre at Stellar
- The building of a canteen.

These are some of the ongoing projects:

- Construction of soccer and volleyball fields, showers and a spectator stand are due to start before the end of this harvest
- The adult IT training facility is up and running and courses have started
- The computer centre at the school is fully operational and a broadband connection has been applied for.
