## A Funeral Ceremony has these purposes

- To express our firm Christian hope of resurrection life in and through Jesus Christ
- To embody the love of a comforting God for those who mourn
- To provide an opportunity for thankful remembrance of the deceased
- To commend the deceased to God as sole caring judge
- To reverently commit the deceased's body to burial or cremation ('disposal')

## The Church of England's Funeral Service has six elements

- 1. Gathering
- 2. Reading and Sermon
- 3. Prayers
- 4. Commendation and Farewell
- 5. Committal
- 6. Dismissal
