We seek to provide spiritual and sacred spaces within our sessions and offer. Opportunities to root ourselves, find space to breathe and an invitation to connect with God.


We offer a broad diet of training, that seeks to meet the diverse needs of each school. Our training and events are open to all, 'take and eat' as much as you need.

You can also use the search function to filter courses to find the session you are looking for.



Booking and non-attendance

Booking is essential for all courses. This allows us to prepare appropriately for all those booked on to the course.

Participants are asked to give at least 48 hours' notice if they need to cancel their place, especially if lunch is being provided. **All** 'no-shows' incur a charge to cover associated costs.


