It's not an extra task—it's naming what you're doing, what's next, and what may need to stop.

S A Three-Way Conversation

Mission is a shared calling between:

- 1. **Parish**: you know your people and community. Your MAP leads the conversation.
- 2. **Deanery**: helps link MAPs, identify shared goals, and add value.

3. **Diocese**: supports your plans, shares learning, and finds resources to help mission thrive.

(*) How to Start (or Restart) Your MAP

- Pray together as a PCC and look honestly at your current mission
- Set 2-3 priorities for the next 12-18 months
- Be realistic. Be honest. Be hopeful.
- Submit your MAP to your deanery and the Diocesan Office

• In multi-parish benefices, MAPs can be combined or tailored—whatever fits your context.

- Celebrate progress
- Adjust direction
- Steward your people and energy wisely
