PASTORAL SCHEME

This Scheme is made by the Church Commissioners ("the Commissioners") this ^{21st} day of ^{March} 2017 in pursuance of the Mission and Pastoral Measure 2011 ("the 2011 Measure"), the Right Reverend Trevor, Bishop of Dover, duly appointed in that behalf pursuant to section 10 of the Dioceses Measure 1978 prior to the taking effect of the Dioceses, Pastoral and Mission Measure 2007, having consented thereto.

WHEREAS

1. by virtue of a Scheme made by the Commissioners in pursuance of the Pastoral Measure 1983 on the 18th day of March 1993 ("the 1993 Scheme") a team ministry was established for the area of the renamed benefice of Saint Laurence in the Isle of Thanet in the diocese of Canterbury;
2. the said Bishop has approved proposals providing for, inter alia, certain amendments to be made to the said team ministry:

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby provided as follows:-

Dissolution of benefice and parish, alteration of area of parish and transfer of parsonage house

1. (1) The benefice of Saint Mark, Ramsgate in the diocese of Canterbury shall be dissolved.
- (2) The parish of Saint Mark, Ramsgate, being the parish comprising the area of the benefice of Saint Mark, Ramsgate, shall also be dissolved and its area shall be transferred to the parish of Saint Laurence in the Isle of Thanet.
- (3) The parsonage house of the benefice of Saint Mark, Ramsgate (known as 198, Margate Road, Ramsgate, CT12 6AQ), together with the site and appurtenances thereof and the grounds usually occupied and enjoyed therewith, shall without any conveyance or other assurance be transferred to the Canterbury Diocesan Board of Finance for diocesan purposes.

Amendment of the 1993 Scheme

2. The 1993 Scheme shall be amended as follows:
 - (a) in clause 1(2) the words "and two other ministers, each of whom shall have the title of vicar" shall be replaced by the words "and one other minister, who shall have the title of vicar";
 - (b) references in the 1993 Scheme to "a vicar", "vicars", "offices of vicar" and the "holders" of such office shall be construed respectively as references to "the vicar", "vicar", "office of vicar" and "holder" where the sense so requires;
 - (c) The Schedule to the 1993 Scheme shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted:-

"SCHEDULE TO THE SCHEME

Constitution of the Patronage Board

The patronage board referred to in clauses 3 and 4(1) of this Scheme shall consist of:-

- (1) the following in right of their respective offices:-

- (a) the Archbishop of Canterbury, who shall be chairman of the board and shall have one vote as a member of the board and a casting vote as chairman;
- (b) the vicar in the team ministry, any member of the team to whom section 34(3) of the 2011 Measure applies and any person having special responsibility for pastoral care under section 34(8) of the 2011 Measure who shall jointly have one vote which shall be exercised by such one of them or such two or more of them (acting unanimously or by a majority) as may be present at the meeting in question;
- (c) for the purpose only of meetings at which the person to be appointed a vicar in the team ministry is considered and chosen, the rector of the team ministry who shall have one vote;

(2) the Church Pastoral Aid Society Patronage Trust, whose registered office is at Sovereign Court One (Unit 3), Sir William Lyons Road, University of Warwick Science Park, Coventry, CV4 7EZ, which shall have one vote.”

Coming into operation of this Scheme

3. If upon the date on which this Scheme is made no person holds an ecclesiastical office under Common Tenure which will be terminated by this Scheme and is in receipt of a stipend and/or other emoluments of office, including accommodation, this Scheme shall come into operation on the first day of the month following the said date; but if on the said date any person holds such an office this Scheme shall come into effect six months thereafter or on such earlier date on which all such offices have been vacated.
